Friendship Garden



Supplies:

- Friendship Garden flower template
- Scissors
- Glue sticks
- Writing instruments (pens, pencils, markers, colored pencils, crayons, etc.)
- Construction Paper



Preparation:

Print a flower template for each person including providers. (colored paper can be used)

Designate a bulletin board or wall space for each group/room to display completed flowers and create your garden.

Directions:

- 1. Each person, including providers gets a flower template. Work together as needed to complete each persons flower.
- 2. Color any part of the flower you would like.
- 3. Cut out the flower shape.
- 4. Use construction paper to add a stem and or leaves to your flower.
- 5. As a group take turns reading your answers to your peers and get to know each other better.
- 6. Add your completed flower to the group/room flower garden.
- 7. Review your friends information throughout the month.

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Fill in the answers and cut out the flower. Add a stem and leaves if you would like. "Plant" your flower in your groups garden. Read others flowers and get to know your peers better.
